After the activity, Mr. Zsakeus Kogoya, the Classis Head of the Kenyam Jerusalem Kingmi Church, said, "Thank you Commander 503, it is the first time TNI and the community have cleaned the Church field together. God bless TNI".

After receiving the activity report, the HABEMA Commanding General, Brigadier General Lucky Avianto, acknowledged the 503 Task Forces' initiative to collaborate with the Kenyam Village community to clean the field of the Kenyam Jerusalem Kingmi Church.
